



Fronted by the North York Rose Garden at the corner of Yonge Street and Park Home Avenue, Gibson Square will rise above the garden's historic apple tree – a reminder of the orchard that David Gibson planted there 150 years ago. Here too can be found the gracious Georgian-style homestead that Gibson built for his family in 1851, which today is the Gibson House Museum, adjacent to pristine parklands providing a verdant setting for this urbane address.
